PROGRAMS

We spent this year strategically incubating and building a community coalition that will roll-out our two Arts-In-Corrections programs in 2020: Juvie Civic Engagement 'Art Attacks' and Virtual Reality for **<u>Returning Individuals.</u>**

This development process culminated with a 2 day event in December where we convened a group of activists, artists, systems-impacted leaders and technological innovators for a Virtual Re-Entry Convening and Teaching Artist Winter Training.
